It causes Kristi to have severe involuntary movement (chorea), depression, mood swings, and has robbed her of her ability to walk and talk, Forcing her to retire after serving 18 years for both Communications Supply Corp and Greenwich High School.

Kristi's two daughter's help take care of their mom, do very well in school And are a testament to the type of mother Kristi was.

Alicia, this past year, was a Co-Captain of the Greenwich High Varsity Cheerleaders, just graduated and is preparing for college in the fall.
